## Safety Advice for the Community What to do if you hear a Public Warning Siren

The **PUBLIC WARNING** siren will consist of a two tone, falling and rising note operating continuously for 3 minutes followed by a 1 minute interval. The **ALL CLEAR** will be a continuous single note lasting for 3 minutes.

### Emergency Safety Advice

This card lists the actions you should take in the event of the activation of the Public Warning Sirens positioned around the perimeter of the Bonnybridge site. Please read this card carefully and discuss it with your family. If you hear a siren at Diageo, Bonnybridge warning you of an emergency:

go in

- 1 Go indoors immediately.
- 2 Close all external doors and windows and turn off ventilation.

tune in

- 3 Tune in to local radio for news information

stay in

- 4 Stay indoors until you receive further instructions from the Emergency Services or Diageo personnel.
- 5 Do not telephone the site as all lines will be required to deal with the emergency.
- 6 Wait until the **ALL CLEAR** is announced which indicates that it is safe to resume your normal activities. This will be communicated by a steady siren note and radio broadcast.
