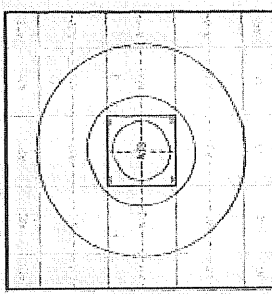

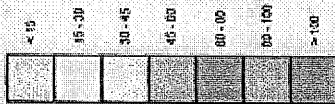

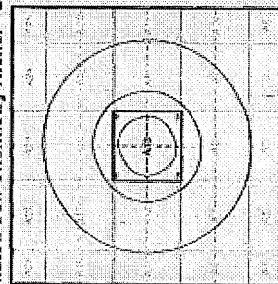

In 1954 the Ordnance Survey was established for mapping urban areas, these maps were then used to update the 1:10,560 maps. The 1:10,560 maps were produced between some years later than the projected date. Before 1931, all OS maps were based on the Cassini Projection, giving rise to significant inaccuracies in surveying. In the late 1940's, a Provisional Edition was produced, which updated the 1:10,560 mapping from a number of sources. The maps appear unfinished – with all military camps and other strategic sites removed. These maps were initially overprinted with the National Grid. In 1970, the first 1:10,000 maps were produced using the Transverse Mercator Projection. 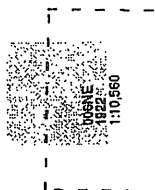

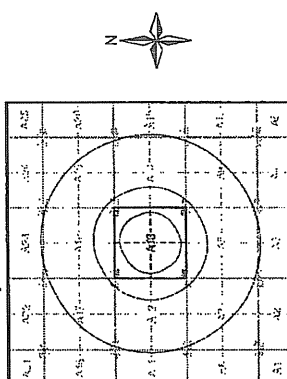

The historical maps shown were reproduced from maps predominantly held at the scale adopted for England, Wales and Scotland in the 1840's, i.e. in 1854 at the 1:250,000 scale was adopted for mapping urban areas, and in 1869 for rural areas. The purpose of the project was to update the 1:250,000 maps. The publication of Ordnance Survey OS maps began some years later than the surveying by Independent surveys of a single county or group of counties. The first edition of the Ordnance Survey map of England was based on the Cassini Projection which had significant inaccuracies in curving northwards. The second edition of the map was produced, which updated the map to a 1:630,000 scale, from a number of sources. The maps appear to have been produced from a number of sources. 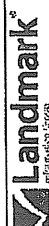

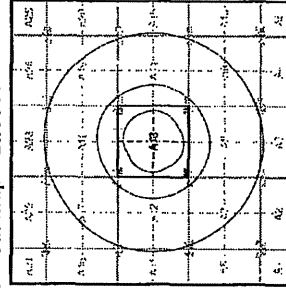
