DISCHARGE OF PLANNING OBLIGATION IN RESPECT OF PLANNING PERMISSION F/81/176 WHICH RESTRICTED IN ALL TIME COMING THE DWELLINGHOUSE ERECTED ON THE SUBJECTS TO OCCUPATION ONLY BY PERSONS EMPLOYED IN AGRICULTURE AND THEIR DEPENDANTS, AND FURTHER REQUIRED THAT THE DWELLINGHOUSE WHICH THE NEW DWELLINGHOUSE REPLACED SHALL NEVER AT ANY TIME BE OCCUPIED AS A DWELLINGHOUSE AND SHALL BE USED AS A FARM OUTBUILDING AT MYOTHILL MAINS, DENNY FK6 5HH FOR MR McISSAC RUSSELL P/14/0190/75D
