Subject: THE RESERVED PLACES LIST FOR SCHOOL SESSION 2015/16

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Reserved places are calculated annually for the purpose of determining how many places can be made available for:

- Placing Requests at each primary and secondary school.
- Non-catchment pupils at primary school nursery classes.

1.2. <u>Legislation</u>

Reserved places are defined in Section 28A(3C) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980 as follows:

"'reserved places' means such number of places (not exceeding such number or, as the case may be, such percentage of places at the school or relating to the particular stage of education as may be prescribed by regulations) as are in the opinion of the education authority reasonably required to accommodate pupils likely to become resident in the catchment area of the school in the period from the time of consideration of the placing request up to and during the year from 1 August to which the placing request relates; and different numbers or, as the case may be, percentages may be prescribed under this subsection for the purpose of different cases or circumstances."

In summary, this means that the Authority can reserve a reasonable number of places in each year group, at each school, as required for the coming/current school session only.

1.3. Falkirk Council Admissions Policy

The Falkirk Council Admissions Policy (November 2012) states that Education Services can refuse Placing Requests on the grounds that vacant places (where they exist) are reserved for children that are likely to move into a school catchment during the forthcoming or current school session.

1.4. Falkirk Council Early Learning and Childcare Admissions Policy

The Falkirk Council Early Learning and Childcare Admissions Policy (April 2015) states that Education Services can refuse a request to enrol a non-catchment pupil in a primary school nursery class on the grounds that vacant places (where they exist) are reserved for children that are likely to move into that school catchment during the forthcoming or current school session.

Nursery pupils are offered places in either the half-day morning or afternoon sessions. A "reserved place" can therefore be defined as a half-day place (amounting to the statutory allocation of 600 hours over the academic year) that could be either morning or afternoon, depending on availability.

1.5. <u>Methodology – Primary and Secondary Reserved Places</u>

The methodology for calculating Reserved Places was detailed in the report to the Education Committee in January 2012. In summary, the formula for calculating reserved places for each year group is as follows:

Reserved Places = 'Number of catchment pupils on the waiting list' + 'Estimated places required for new housing' + 'Estimated places required for pupils moving into the area'

1.6. Methodology - Nursery Reserved Places

The methodology for calculating Reserved Places was detailed in the report to the Education Committee in April 2015. In summary, the formula for calculating reserved places is as follows:

- 1 reserved place for every 20 half-day places based on the planned nursery class capacity for the coming school session.
- Plus, where applicable, 1 reserved place for every 20 new houses that are expected to be built up to and during the coming school session.
- 1.7. Placing requests are not normally granted where they would take up places reserved for pupils that are likely to move into the school catchment during the coming or current school session. The pupils living in the catchment area that are waiting for a place at a school are also added to the Reserved Places total.
- 1.8. This report provides the detailed Reserved Places List that has been calculated for the 2015/16 school session.
