### 1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Four companies were invited to submit quotations, using the Public Contracts Scotland Portal online quotation facility, in respect of Wildlife Consultancy Services for the demolition of the former Police Station and Registrar's Office, Main Street, Stenhousemuir, in accordance with Standing Order 8.3 relating to contracts.

### 2. QUOTATIONS RECEIVED

- 2.1 Two quotations were received by the due date of 24<sup>th</sup> July 2015 and opened at 11.15am on the 27<sup>th</sup> July 2015, in accordance with Standing Order 11 relating to contracts.
- 2.2 The quotation prices ranged from £2,110.00 to £2,737.00.
- 2.3 Following the evaluation of both quotations, it was considered best value for the Council to accept the quotation from Echoes Ecology Ltd., Unit 39, Hayfield Business Centre, Marchmont Avenue, Polmont, in the sum of £2,110.00
- 2.4 The quotation can be contained within the block expenditure figure for Housing Development, identified in the Housing Investment 3 Year Programme 2015/2017.
