Reason(s):

- The application does not accord with Policy ENV. 1 of the approved Falkirk Council Structure Plan, Policy Rural 1 and Rural 13 of the adopted Rural Local Plan and Policy SC3 and EQ23 of the Falkirk Council Local Plan Finalised Draft (Deposit Version) (April 2007) as amended by the Final Proposed Modifications (June 2010) as it has not been demonstrated that a countryside location is essential for the proposed dwellinghouse and the proposed dwellinghouse is not considered to represent an appropriate infill opportunity. The proposed development therefore represents unjustified development in the countryside.
- The proposal would result in vehicular access onto a rural road at a position with high vehicle speeds, leading to an increase in vehicular and pedestrian traffic, all to the detriment of road safety.
