Thank you for your application which we received on 05 June.

You have consulted us because you believe the development may affect:

- **Battle of Linlithgow Bridge**

We have considered your application, and we consider the proposals do not raise issues of national significance such that we would object.

However, we comment as follows:

The location of the proposed house lies just within the western boundary of the site of the *Battle of Linlithgow Bridge*, and would be a minor extension of the currently developed housing area. It would therefore not have a significant impact on the understanding of the battlefield site. We do however suggest that you should consult your council's archaeological advisor to ensure that consideration is given to the potential for the discovery of archaeological finds within the development site.
