2.4 Appendix 3 details the 9 parades notified to the licensing authority that are currently pending. This differs from the other applications received as the statutory requirement is for the Licensing Authority to be notified of a proposed parade or march rather than for an organisation to apply for a licence to hold a parade or march.

3. Applications determined by the Director of Corporate & Housing Services

- 3.1 During the period of recess the Chief Governance Officer, on behalf of the Director of Corporate & Housing Services, using delegated powers afforded to him, and having consulted with the Convener of the Civic Licensing Committee, granted licences that would normally have been considered by the Civic Licensing Committee.
- 3.2 Application for the variation of Taxi Operator Licence No 49 The licenceholder replaced a taxi with a purpose built Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle that was older than the current age policy permits. The extent to which it did not meet the policy was marginal.
- 3.3 Applications for 2 additional Taxi operator licences An individual submitted 2 applications for taxi operator licences. Any additional operator licences require to be considered by Committee under normal circumstances.
- 3.4 The Chief Governance Officer considered that the substitute WAV taxi should be allowed due to the purpose built nature of the vehicle. The additional operator licences were granted as there were no issues with the vehicles.
