EX88. Gaelic Language Plan

The Executive considered a report by the Director of Children's Services which provided, as an appendix, the second iteration of Falkirk's draft Gaelic Language Plan for submission to Bord na Gàidhlig prior to public consultation.

All local authorities and public bodies were legally required to create a Gaelic Language Plan which would be reviewed every 5 years resulting in the adoption of a new plan. The plan outlined how the Council would support and increase Gaelic language and culture.

The first iteration of the plan had been implemented in March 2013 and the second iteration was due for approval by Bord na Gaidhlig on 5 March 2018. Following approval of the plan by Bord na Gaidhlig a 6 week public consultation.

Decision

The Executive agreed the Falkirk draft Gaelic Language Plan.
