There are no known archaeological sites within the proposed development area. Torwood Castle lies to the south and Torwood Castle and the Roman road to the south-west, but these are some distance away. The nearest site of historic interest is the massive quarry immediately to the south-west. It is so old that it does not even appear on the first edition OS map in 1860. It is believed that the stone was used in the construction of Stirling Castle.

However, the proposed housing stops just shy of the quarry. The topsoil coverage on the site is shallow and so the probability of any archaeological remains of significance is slight. We therefore have no objections to the proposed development.
