Good to talk to you earlier.

As discussed, TPU are currently in the process of letting a tender to operate an EV car club in the area, focussed on the town centre with some cars further afield. The car club is being funded for two years through Transport Scotland's Switched on Towns and Cities Challenge Fund. We are hoping that the operator will be able to continue the car club beyond the initial two year period on a commercial basis, but we will be investigating further funding opportunities nearer the time. Other Local Authorities have used developer contributions to fund/extend car clubs, and if there were opportunities to do that here then we would welcome it
