Anticipated that a report with options for each location will be forthcoming at the March 2023 executive.</p> <p>Having considered this matter further officers have noted that it would be more appropriate for this activity to progress to Committee in parallel with the School Transport Criteria review which will report later in 2023. This will ensure a joined up approach in supporting pupils safely to school.</p> <p>Officers will be bringing forward a Transport Planning Review committee paper to the Executive on 28 November 2023, where this matter will be considered.</p>
