HSC14. REVIEW OF COMMUNITY CARE LOCALITY AND INTEGRATED TEAMS

There was submitted Report (circulated) dated 17 April 2009 by the Acting Director of Social Work Services (a) advising of progress on the Review of Community Care Locality and Integrated Teams, (b) attaching to the Report, Appendices outlining the proposed models for future service delivery arising from the review and the consultation process, and (c) seeking agreement to undertake further work on a preferred model, including piloting some aspects of this, in order to establish whether it can be successfully implemented and can achieve the anticipated benefits.

The options proposed were:-

Model A – minor changes to the existing arrangements, or Model B – introduction of a specific intake service.

Councillor Goldie, seconded by Councillor McNeill, moved the recommendations as contained within the Report.

By way of an amendment, Councillor Meiklejohn, seconded by Councillor McNally moved that Model A be worked up with a focus on ensuring that there are robust and standardised procedures which will provide equity and consistency of approach in assessment and provision across the district.

On a division, 6 Members voted for the Motion and 5 Members for the Amendment.

Accordingly, **NOTED** the work undertaken on the Review.

AGREED that:-

- (1) Model B be worked up in more detail;
- (2) aspects of Model B be piloted; and
- (3) the Acting Director of Social Work Services provide an updated Report once the detail of the model and the outcome of the pilot are available.
