## 1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 This report supplements our principal report on the Revenue Budget and provides Members with the outcome of the discussions on funding to external organisations at the Housing and Social Care Committee. The Report from the Acting Director of Social Work Services to that Committee is attached as an appendix to this Report.

- 6.2 acknowledge and recognise the work undertaken by the organisations described in Appendices 1 and 2 in supporting and assisting local people;
- 6.3 endorse the proposals, as outlined in Table 1 for extension of Joint Working Agreements, mainly being one year extensions only at this time and refer consideration of funding levels for these organisations to Falkirk Council as part of the 2010/11 budget setting process;
- 6.4 endorse the proposals outlined in Section 3 to discontinue funding to the 3 services outlined i.e. Barnardo's Matrix, Children 1<sup>st</sup> Family Group Conferencing Service and FDAMH Time Out Service, on the basis that the needs of service users can be appropriately met through alternative existing service provision and that due notice will be provided to these organisations and refer this to Falkirk Council for approval as part of the 2010/11 budget considerations, and
- 6.5 ask the Acting Director of Social Work Services to ensure that all grant funded activity is reviewed in the next 12 months, where necessary in conjunction with other Council Services, to ensure financial and strategic fit from 2011 onwards.
- 1.3 Cllr Meiklejohn seconded by Cllr McNally moved an amendment in the following terms:-
  - (1) in paragraph 6.4 to delete reference to the FDAMH Time Out Service;
  - (2) to insert a new paragraph 6.5

"Recognise the excellent support services that Falkirk and District Association for Mental Health provide to those with mental health difficulties, that the Time out – Crisis Out of Hours Service is a valuable addition to the services already provided, endorse continued financial support for 2010/11 and refer this to Falkirk Council for consideration as part of the 2010/11 budget considerations; and

- (3) re-number existing paragraph 6.5 accordingly.
- 1.4 On a roll call vote the following votes were cast: -

For the Motion (7) – Councillors Blackwood, Buchanan, Gow, C MacDonald, McLuckie, McNeill and Patrick.

For the Amendment (5) – Councillors Constable, Jackson, A MacDonald, McNally and Meiklejohn.

Accordingly the Motion was carried by 7 votes to 5.

The following recommendations are referred for consideration or approval by Council:-

- (1) to endorse the proposals, as outlined in Table 1 for extension of Joint Working Agreements, mainly being one year extensions only at this time and refer consideration of funding levels for these organisations to Falkirk Council as part of the 2010/11 budget setting process, and
- (2) to endorse the proposals outlined in Section 3 to discontinue funding to the 3 services outlined i.e Barnardo's Matrix, Children 1<sup>st</sup> Family Group Conferencing Service and FDAMH Time Out Service, on the basis that the needs of service users can be

appropriately met through alternative existing service provision and that due notice will be provided to these organisations and refer this to Falkirk Council for approval as part of the 2010/11 budget considerations
