LTC13. COMMONWEALTH GAMES - DELHI HANDOVER CEREMONY

There was submitted Report (circulated) dated 13 May 2010 by the Director of Community Services seeking approval of Council funding up to £6,000 towards supporting up to 6 young people to participate in the Delhi Commonwealth Handover Ceremony in October 2010, leading up to the Commonwealth Games in Glasgow in 2014.

Discussion took place on the following issues:-

- That each local authority in Scotland was offered 9 places for young people to attend; and
- The importance of providing support to young people in the Falkirk Council area and recognising the life long benefit and self development opportunities.

Councillor Mahoney, seconded by Provost Reid, moved that the Committee approve the recommendations within the Report.

By way of an Amendment, Councillor McNally, seconded by Councillor Meiklejohn, moved that, by way of an addition to the recommendation:-

'Council desires where necessary to cover the total cost to participants and asks that Committee approach Education Services and the Provost, where appropriate, to guarantee this.'

On a division, 7 Members voted for the Motion and 4 Members voted for the Amendment.

Accordingly, **NOTED** the Report and **AGREED** to receive regular Reports on local activity linked to the London Olympics 2012 and Glasgow Commonwealth Games in 2014.
