1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 On 15 December 2010, the Licensing Board approved the dates for meetings of the Board for the period to December 2011. The purpose of this report is to suggest a programme for meetings for 2012.
- 1.2 In terms of paragraph 4 of Schedule 1 to the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, the tenure of office of members of the Board comes to an end at the first meeting of the Council after the local government elections on 3 May 2012 at which stage paragraph 2 of the Schedule requires the new Board to be elected. The date of that first meeting of the Council is not yet determined but requires to be held not later than 21 days after the local government elections i.e. by 24 May 2012. These statutory provisions ensure that there is no period during which there is not a competent Licensing Board in existence.
