2. Main Challenges

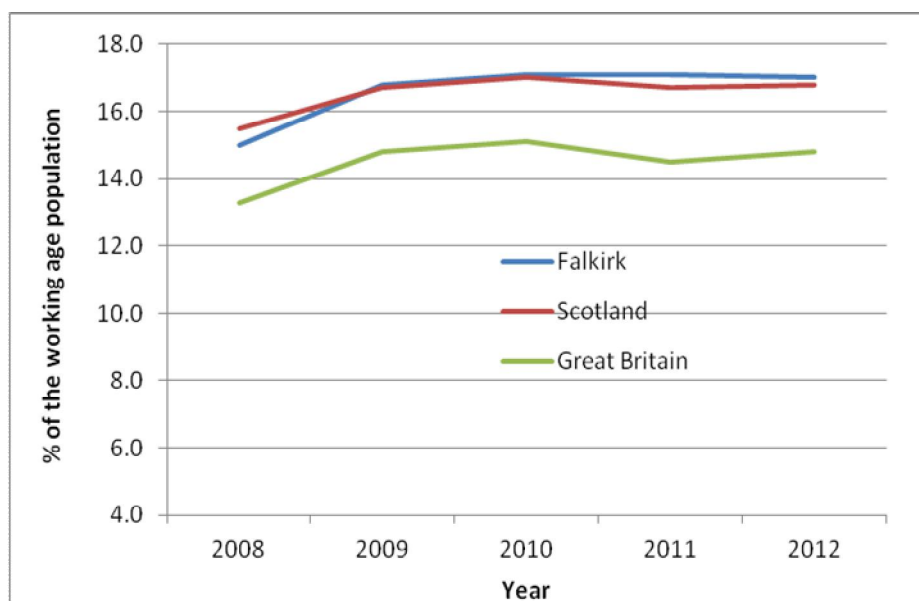
Sick and Disabled

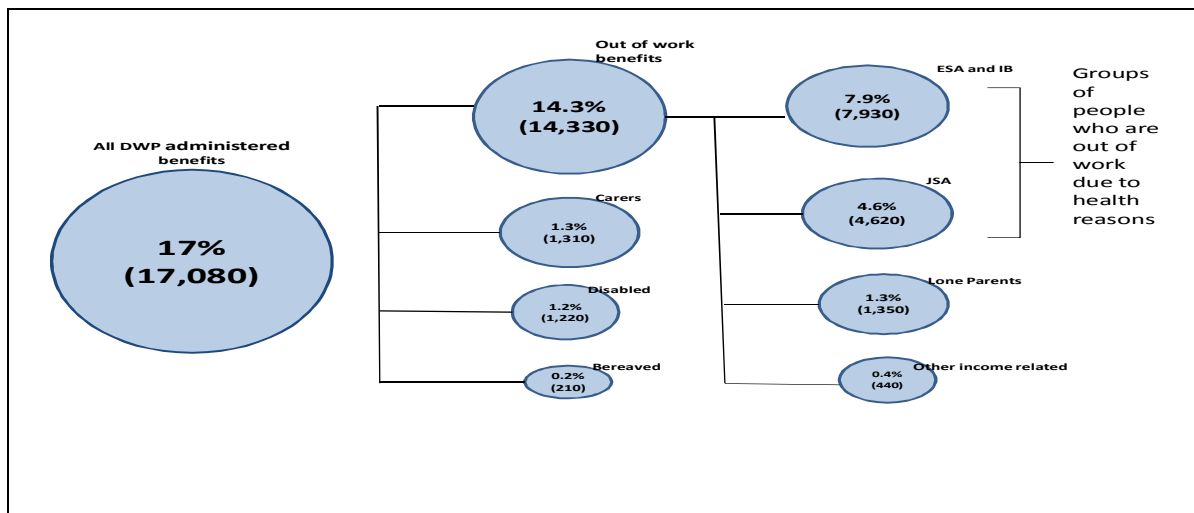
24.2%¹ of households in Falkirk claim council tax or housing benefits, or both.

Below is a breakdown of DWP benefit claimants by statistical group based on the percentage of working age population @August 2012.

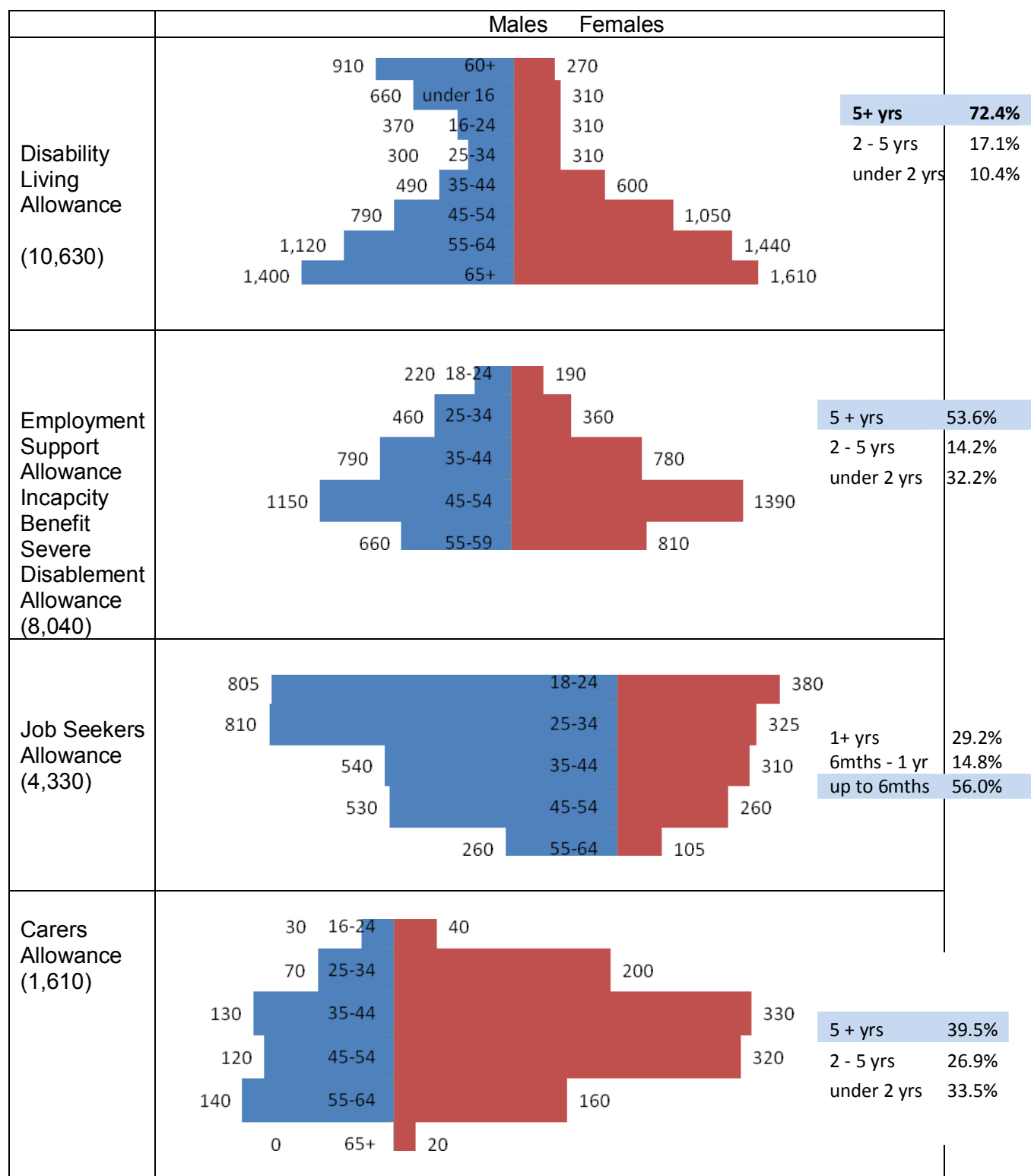

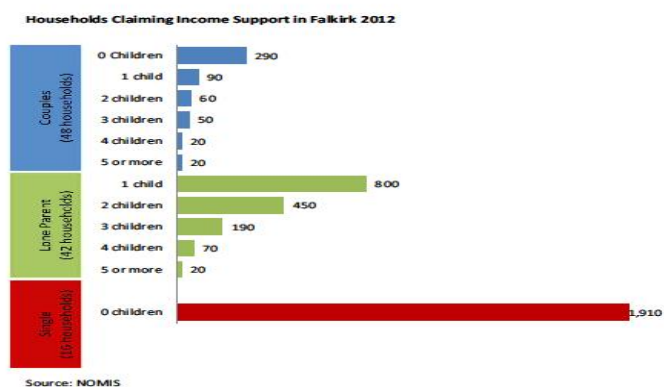

- Total % of population on ESA & IB 5.2%

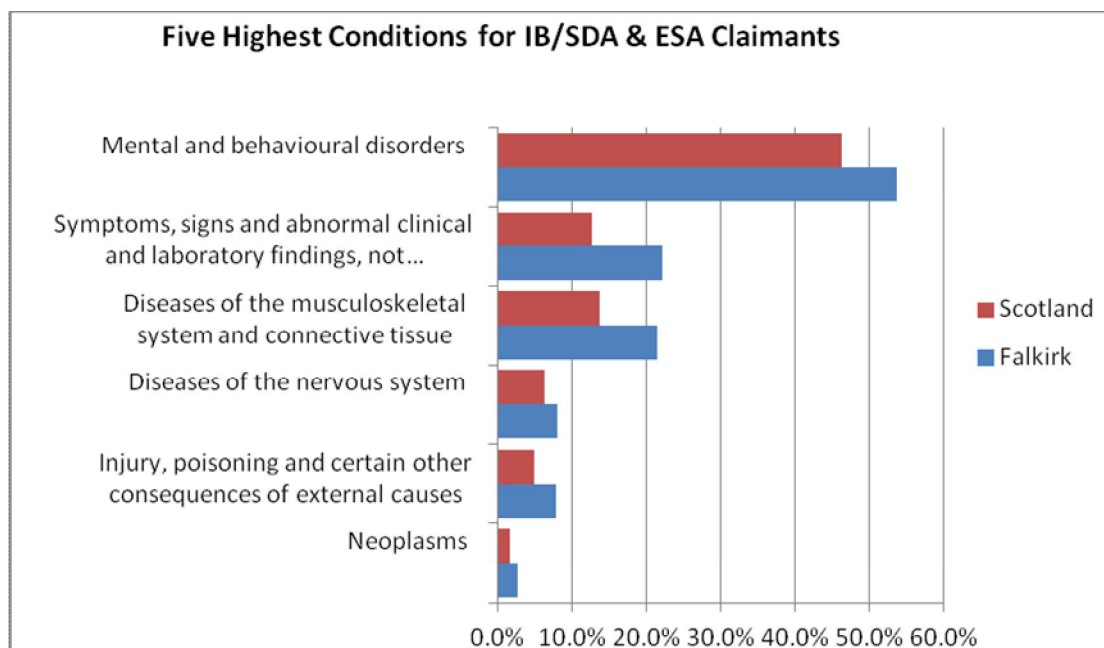

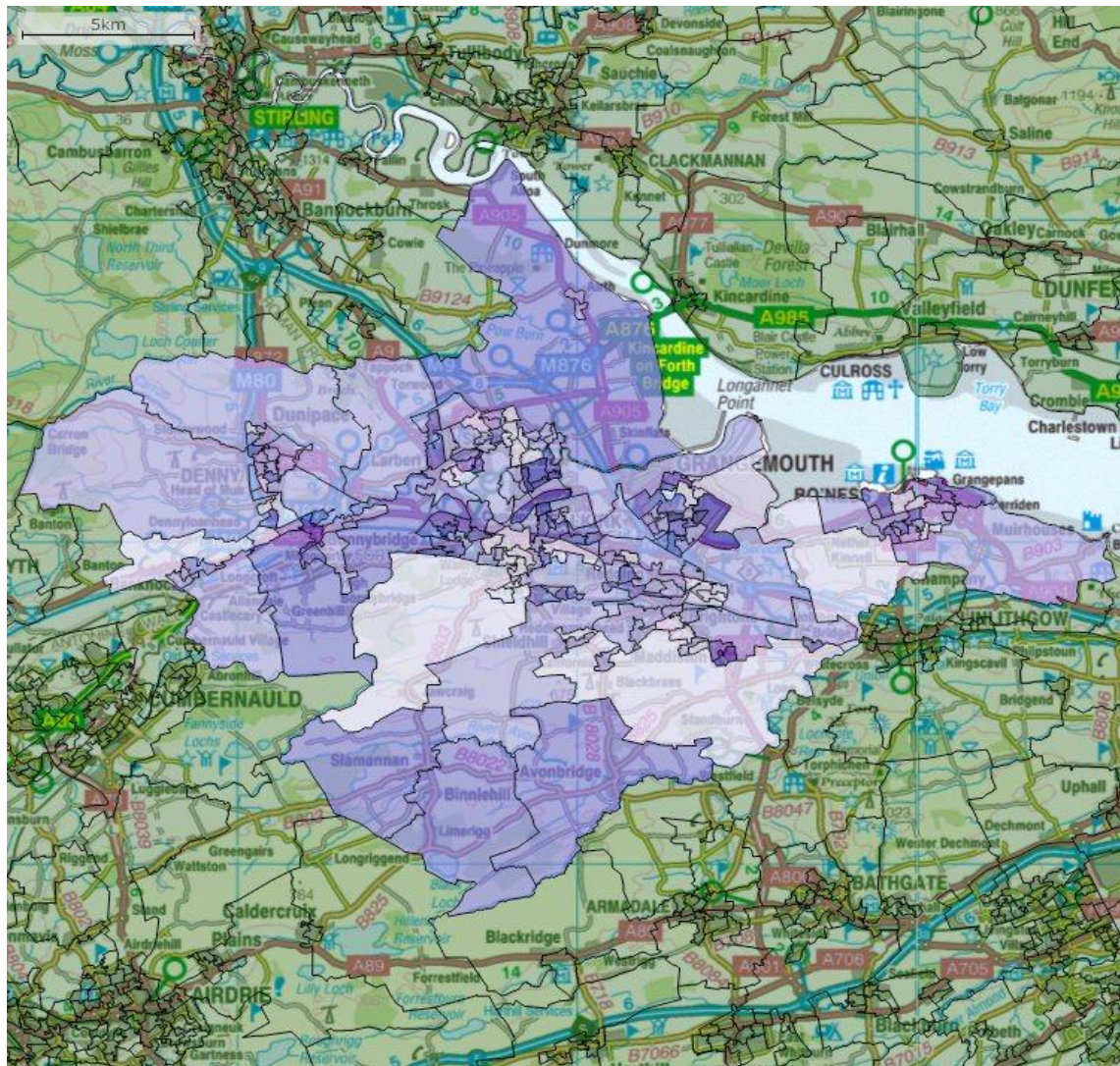

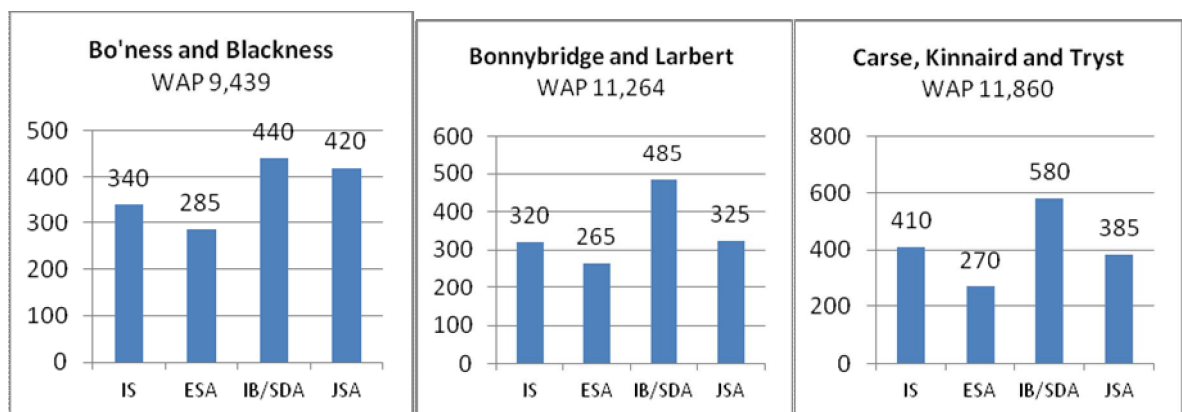
Average weekly credit pension payment in Falkirk is £50.51 (there are 7,260 claimants in receipt of Pension Credits in Falkirk).

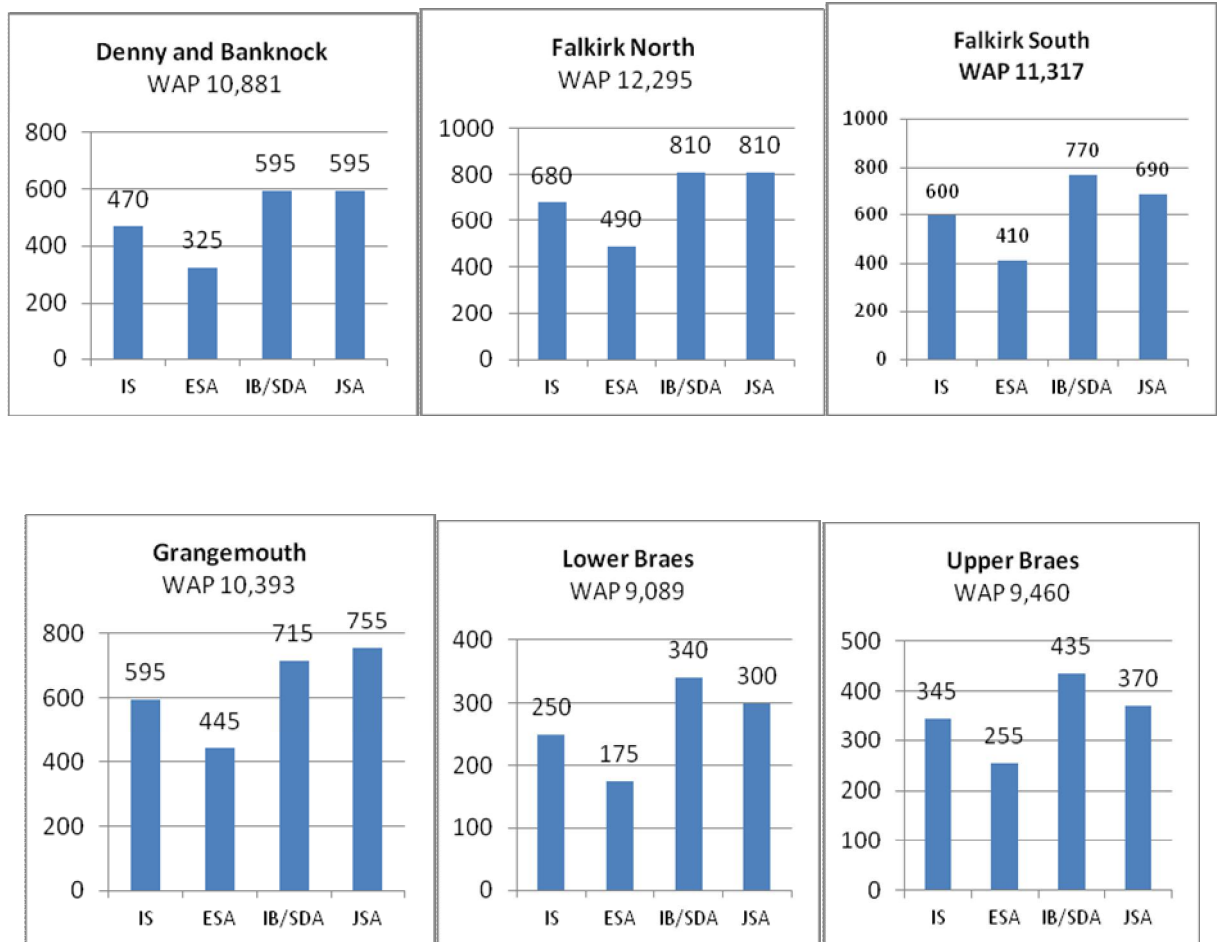
Impact on Places
