1. BACKGROUND

1.1 The purpose of this report is to give an outline of the work carried out by the Licensing Board during 2013 in relation to activity under the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

2. BUDGETARY INFORMATION

- 2.1 The financial year runs from 1 April to 31 March the following year. In terms of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, however, the annual retention fee is payable midway through the financial year on 1 October for all Premises Licences in effect or suspended on that date or, in any other case, 30 days after the date on which the licence takes effect. The income generated from the annual retention fees is therefore split equally between consecutive financial years; the income received from the annual retention fees in October 2013 being added to 50% of the retention fee income from October 2012. The remaining 50% of the October 2013 retention income is carried forward at the end of March 2013 into the 2014/15 budget.
- 2.2 The collection of the 2013 annual retention fee was again carried out in conjunction with Falkirk Council's Sundry Accounts Team who issued invoices, a reminder and a final reminder. All invoices were issued timeously to give licenceholders 30 days' notice as required by the Act. The annual fee income gathered in respect of Premises Licences in effect or suspended on 1 October 2013 is circa £121,760.

3. CURRENT LICENCES

3.1 The table below shows the total number of licences in force on 11 December 2013:

4 NEW PREMISES LICENCES

4.1 During 2013, two applications for new premises licences have been granted by the Board; these being Cowden Bonnybridge petrol station and Ada Polish shop, Bo'ness. In addition, seven applications for provisional premises licences have been granted by the Board; these being Aldi in Camelon, 1a Central Avenue in Grangemouth, Laurie's Bar in Laurieston, Mannerstons Limited in Rouken Glen, Carronvale Filling Station and Sainsbury's in Larbert, and Nando's in the Central Retail Park, Falkirk. The premises licences in respect of 1a Central Avenue and Laurie's Bar are not yet in force as the confirmation application has not yet been submitted.

5 VARIATIONS TO PREMISES LICENCES

- 5.1 35 applications for non minor variations to premises licences were received during 2013. This type of application requires to be determined by the Licensing Board. Twenty-nine of these applications have been granted by the Board, one has been put on hold at the request of the agent, and five are being processed.
- 5.2 During 2013, thirty three applications to make a minor variation to a premises licence were received. These were for different types of changes including updating personal details, a decrease in the capacity (alcohol display area), change of store layout etc. One application is still being processed. In addition, eighty-one applications to change the Designated Premises Manager were received. Eighty were granted under delegated powers and one application was withdrawn.
- 5.3 Nineteen applications to transfer premises licences were received during 2013. Of these, 16 have been granted and three are still being processed.

6. PREMISES LICENCE REVIEWS

- 6.1 Seven applications to review premises licences were received during 2013. Six of these applications were made by the Chief Constable of Police Scotland (Central Scotland Police prior to 1 April 2013) and one by the Licensing Standards Officer in terms of section 36 of the Act. The Board made a finding in terms of section 84 of the Act in relation to the premises licence reviews for The Phoenix in Whitecross, RK Foodstore in Bainsford and The Local Store in Denny to review the personal licences of persons working in the premises. The hearings in relation to the Newtown Bar in Bo'ness, Barrie Foodstore in Grangemouth and Gateside Mini Market in Bonnybridge commenced on 10 December 2013 but have yet to be concluded.
- 6.2 Information on the outcome of the premises licence reviews is noted below:

7. OCCASIONAL LICENCES

- 7.2 Appendix 1 gives details of these applications by type of applicant and shows the nature of the function and the hours sought.
- 7.3 Only one application for an occasional licence required to be determined by the Board in 2013, following submission of an objection from a member of the public. This was an application from Larbert Orange Lodge for a fundraising dance at Camelon Memorial Hall. Following a hearing, the licence was granted with the imposition of conditions to address the objector's concerns.

8. EXTENDED HOURS APPLICATIONS

8.1 The table below show the applications received for extended hours in 2013 by month together with the numbers granted, withdrawn, refused or fallen. It will be noted that there are two 'spikes' – March and October/November. The increase in applications in March is due to Bank Holidays which fall in the following month(s) namely Easter and May Day. These Bank Holidays are recognised in the Board's current Statement of Licensing Policy and licence holders take advantage of the extra hour by applying for extended hours.

The spike which occurs later in the year is in relation to the Festive Period. The dates of the Festive Period are detailed in the Board's current Statement of Licensing Policy and the policy currently allows an extra hour of trading during this period, dealt with by way of an extended hours application. Any applications which are outwith policy, most commonly as they are for more than one hour or are for events that are outwith the Board's Festive period, have to be determined by the Board.

10. PERSONAL LICENCE REVIEWS

10.1 The Licensing Board reviewed four personal licences during 2013. Three of the reviews followed a finding in terms of section 84 of the Act in relation to the premises licence reviews for The Phoenix in Whitecross, RK Foodstore in Bainsford and The Local Store in Denny while the fourth review followed an application from Police Scotland. The personal licences in each case were endorsed.

11. **MISCELLANEOUS TASKS**

In 2013, the Licensing Section, on behalf of the Licensing Board, responded to two Scottish 11.1 Government Licensing Consultations; Further Options for Alcohol Licensing and Review of Alcohol Licensing Fees. A response was also submitted

to the NHS Consultation with stakeholders on drug and alcohol information development.

11.2 Work was undertaken by the Licensing Section and the Corporate Policy Unit in relation to addressing the responsibilities of the Board in terms of the Equalities Act 2010, particularly in relation to the development of an Equalities Strategy. Following consultation, the Board approved the strategy at its meeting on 23 October 2013.

11.3 In 2010, the Licensing Board adopted the Single Model Publication Scheme, which was produced and approved by the Scottish Information Commissioner until 31 May 2013. The Scheme was updated and approved by the Commissioner until 31 May 2017. The scheme is published on Falkirk Council's website
