

## **Royal Mail Industrial Action**

Pension payments are made on the 15th of each month with a payslip being sent to the home address of each pensioner.

At present, there is uncertainty as to whether there will be further industrial action by staff of Royal Mail. In the event of such industrial action, it is possible that there may be some delay in future pension payslips being delivered. We apologise for this inconvenience should it arise.

Pensioners are reminded that their monthly payment does not depend on a payslip being delivered to their home address. The process of crediting funds to pensioners bank or building society accounts is entirely separate from the production of monthly payslips.

As such, pensioners should note that funds will continue to be credited to accounts on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month, except where the 15<sup>th</sup> falls on a weekend or bank holiday in which case payments will be credited on the first working day immediately prior to the said weekend or bank holiday.
