Falkirk Council Educational Psychology Service is part of Education Services. We work mainly in nurseries, primary and secondary schools and special schools or units.

We work with your parents or carers, teachers and other people who know you, to look at what kind of help you need. Sometimes we may also work with you, always with the permission of you and your parents or carers. We may come into your class, look at your work or meet to talk with you about how you are getting on at school.

We give advice and work with other people so that pupils can do well at school. At times we work with a group of pupils or a whole class, about things such as friendship or bullying. We would usually work together with one of your teachers when doing this.

If you are worried about how you are getting on at school you should talk to your parents or your teacher. If your teacher feels it would be a good idea to get us involved, they will talk with your parents about this and how it should happen. Your parents and teacher will then talk with you.
