4. Supplementary Information

- (a) A "Scheme Employer" is any organisation which is required by statute to offer the Local Government Pension Scheme to it's staff. e.g. Local Authorities, Police Forces, Fire Brigades, Colleges of Further or Higher Education, Water Authorities, Area Tourist Boards, SCRA, SEPA, etc.
- (b) Approval under Category 3(a)(ii) is subject to such conditions as the Scottish Ministers think fit and they may withdraw approval at any time if such conditions are not met.
- (c) Applications are subject to the approval of Falkirk Council and the Inland Revenue.
- (d) Applications require applicants to identify an organisation willing to act as their guarantor in relation to their participation in the Fund. A guarantor will be a signatory to the admission agreement. In the event of the admission body ceasing to participate in the Fund, the guarantor will be required to meet any outstanding liabilities arising from the body's participation.
