1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The purpose of this report is to update Members on the progress and performance of Bo'ness Fair Festival Committee for the period 2012/2013. This report is compliant with Falkirk Council procedure in relation to 'Following the Public Pound' requirements.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Bo'ness Fair Festival Committee Executive is a registered charity that fundraises for and organises the annual Children's Fair Festival each year. The event has been running in its current form since 1897.
- 2.2 The Council and its predecessor authorities have provided in-kind support to this event since local government re-organisation in 1975. The in-kind support is currently provided by Corporate & Neighbourhood Services, Development Services and also Falkirk Community Trust. The Council is invoiced for the cost of the staging, stewarding and toilet hire, provided by external organisations. The budget for the current year is £30,429. Financial assistance is not given directly to the Bo'ness Fair Committee.
