

P110. THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (ELPHINSTONE CRESCENT, MAIN STREET AND MILLER PLACE, AIRTH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2013 (CONTINUATION)

With reference to Minutes of Meetings of the Planning Committee held on 30 October and 27 November 2013 (Paragraphs P93 and P105 refer), Committee (a) gave further consideration to a report by the Director of Development Services, and (b) considered an additional report by the said Director seeking a decision on the Falkirk Council (Elphinstone Crescent, Main Street and Miller Place, Airth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2013 to implement waiting restrictions on the junctions outside Airth Primary School.

Councillor C Martin, seconded by Councillor Nimmo, moved that the Order be made subject to a reduction in the extent of the waiting restrictions on Elphinstone Crescent at the junction with Main Street, to include the dropped kerb and extending towards Miller Place for two metres.

By way of an amendment, Councillor Carleschi, seconded by Councillor Turner, moved that the Order be made in accordance with the recommendations in the report.

On a division, 5 Members voted for the motion and 4 for the amendment.

Decision

The Committee agreed to make the Traffic Regulation Order referred to in the Report subject to a reduction in the extent of the waiting restrictions on Elphinstone Crescent at the junction with Main Street, to include the dropped kerb and extending towards Miller Place for two metres.
