

P10. USE OF LAND FOR END OF LIFE VEHICLE DECONTAMINATION AND DELIQUIDISING FACILITY AND STORAGE OF SCRAP MATERIAL (RETROSPECTIVE) AT ALL PARTS AUTO SALVAGE, HILLVIEW ROAD, HIGH BONNYBRIDGE, BONNYBRIDGE FK4 2BD FOR ALL PARTS AUTO SALVAGE - P/14/0094/FUL

With reference to Minute of Meeting of the Planning Committee held on 25 March 2015 (Paragraph P132 refers), Committee (a) gave further consideration to a report by the Director of Development Services; and (b) considered an additional report by the said Director on an application for full planning permission for the use of land for an end of life vehicle decontamination and deliquidising facility and storage of scrap material (retrospective) at All Parts Auto Salvage, Hillview Road, High Bonnybridge, Bonnybridge.
