### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The contract for the proposed re-instatement of fire damaged residential properties at Stirling Street, Denny was advertised on the Public Contracts Scotland Portal and, following assessment of submitted pre-qualification questionnaires, six companies were subsequently invited to tender.

#### 2. TENDERS RECEIVED

- 2.1 Six tenders were received by the due date of Wednesday, 6<sup>th</sup> May 2015 and opened at 2.30pm on Wednesday, 6<sup>th</sup> May 2015 in accordance with Standing Order 11 relating to contracts.
- 2.2 The tendered prices ranged from £254,291.08 to £348,877.81.
- 2.3 Following the evaluation of tenders it was considered best value for the Council to award the contract to Marshall Construction Ltd, The Whins, Alloa, Clackmannanshire, FK10 3TA for the sum of £254,291.08.
- 2.4 The tender can be contained within the 2015/2016 Corporate and Neighbourhood Services Housing Repairs and Maintenance (Fire Damage) budget.
- 2.5 In accordance with Standing Order 6.2(ii) relating to contracts, I consulted with the Chief Governance Officer prior to entering into contract with that party.

#### 3. ACTION TAKEN

3.1 Members note that, in accordance with Standing Order 6.2(ii), I have accepted the tender submitted by Marshall Construction Ltd, The Whins, Alloa, Clackmannanshire, FK10 3TA in the sum of £254,291.08 in respect of the proposed re-instatement of fire damaged residential properties at Stirling Street, Denny.
