1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The aim of this paper is to brief the Audit Committee on the progress on the 2016/17 internal audit plan.

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 The Audit Committee is asked to:

- Note the progress on the 2016/17 internal audit plan.
- Approve the proposed amendment to the 2016/17 plan.

3. BACKGROUND

3.1 Work on the completion of the internal audit plan is continuing and progress is as expected. Internal Audit staff from Falkirk Council and NHS Forth Valley have met and, together with the Chief Finance Officer, have discussed and agreed shared working arrangements.

Since approval of the internal audit plan in June 2016, the Chief Officer and Chief Finance Officer have discussed progress with the Chief Internal Auditor. All parties are agreed that bed modelling is not yet at a stage where the planned audit, FK07-17 – Capacity Planning & Bed Modelling could add value. Therefore it is proposed that this be replaced with an audit of Clinical and Care Governance, to ensure that these key governance arrangements are in place and working effectively.

4. MAIN BODY OF THE REPORT

4.1 The following audit product, with the audit opinion shown, has been issued in 2016/17. This was reported in full to the Falkirk IJB at its meeting on 5 August 2016. An update on how the actions arising from this report are being addressed is included under a separate agenda item.
