- 3.2 There is currently a vacancy on the Board which falls to be filled by an Independent elected member. Falkirk Council will consider this appointment at its next meeting on 28 June 2017.

4. Appointment of Convener and Depute Convener

- 4.1. In terms of paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 1 to the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, the Licensing Board must, at its first meeting after each election of Members of the Board, elect one of its Members as Convener of the Board.
- 4.2. Paragraph 6(5) of the said Schedule states that if the Convener is for any reason unable to chair any meeting of the Board, the Board must, at the meeting, elect another of its Members to chair that meeting.
- 4.3. Previously Falkirk Licensing Board has elected a member as Depute Convener for this purpose providing clarity over who takes the chair in the Convener's absence.
