**1. Purpose of Report**

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to appoint two pupil representatives and a care experienced young person as non-voting members to the Education, Children and Young People Executive.

**2. Recommendations**

**2.1 The Education, Children and Young People Executive is asked to appoint:-**

- (1) Ryan Farmer and Beth Wallace as the two Pupil Representatives on the Education, Children and Young People Executive, with immediate effect for a period of one year, and**
- (2) Siobhan O'Neill as the Care Experienced Young Person on the Education, Children and Young People Executive, with immediate effect until the next local government elections.**

**3. Background**

- 3.1 The Education, Children and Young People Executive has authority to appoint non-elected members to its membership within the categories agreed by Council. Pupil representatives and the care experienced young person members do not have voting rights.
- 3.2 In line with Children Service's current selection process for pupil representatives, Graeme High School was asked to nominate 2 pupils for 2019/20. Ryan Farmer and Beth Wallace were nominated by the Head Teacher of Graeme High School.
- 3.3 Council agreed on 8 May 2019 to extend the membership of the Education, Children and Young People Executive to create a new category of non-voting member for a care experienced young person, and that the appointment be by nomination of the Champions Board. Siobhan O'Neill was nominated by the Champions Board.
