FC22. Falkirk Integration Joint Board Report

Council considered a report by the Chief Officer - Falkirk Health & Social Care Partnership which provided information on the redesign of residential care.

There were four in-house residential care homes across the localities and one Intermediate Care Facility. Torwoodhall was one of the oldest buildings in which residential care was provided. Due to the layout and style of the building it was difficult to provide care that met current and future requirements for infection control.

The IJB approved a review of Torwoodhall that would consider the residents' needs and the provision of care in alternative settings. The report considered by the IJB was provided as an appendix. The IJB would consider the outcome of the review at its meeting on 20 November 2020.
