

IJB25. Remobilisation Update

The Integration Joint Board considered a report by the Head of Integration which updated on progress of the plans for Remobilisation, Recovery and Redesign during the period of the Covid 19 pandemic. The plan was in line with national guidance relating to fluctuating patterns of the virus. The report gave a high-level summary of the current actions being undertaken.

Locality teams had made some progress over the last few weeks to reduce the number of people awaiting packages of care and continued to explore ways to address unmet need.

The expansion of the day service provision had been halted so that all available staff could continue to be deployed to support critical service delivery. Staff had been relocated from some areas to more critical roles to ensure safe ongoing delivery of vital services. There was proactive recruitment to a significant number of vacant posts and a wide-reaching recruitment campaign to fill vacancies was being launched.

Review of the remobilisation plan had highlighted that whilst a significant proportion of actions continued to be on track there had been some areas, due for completion by September 2021, which had been delayed and the plan had been amended to reflect the revised time scale of December 2021.

Decision

The Integration Joint Board noted:-

- (1) the impact of systemic pressures and the impact this had on previously agreed timescales;**
- (2) the current actions being undertaken by the HSCP to support the recovery phase of the Covid 19 pandemic, while recognising and maintaining a level of preparedness due to the fluctuating nature of the pandemic.**
