

IJB27. Community Planning Partnership Plan 2021-2031

The Integration Joint Board considered a report by the Directory of Corporate and Housing Services which updated on the content and timelines of Falkirk Community Planning Partnership's Local Outcome Improvement Plan, called the Falkirk Plan.

The report detailed the process of development of the plan, its core findings and how it would be delivered. The Falkirk Plan focused on six main themes for the next ten years, which were:-

- Theme 1: Working in Partnership with our Communities
- Theme 2: Poverty
- Theme 3: Mental Health
- Theme 4: Substance Use
- Theme 5: Domestic Abuse and Gender-based Violence
- Theme 6: Economic Recovery and Employment

Each theme identified a specific set of outcomes that would be delivered on by Falkirk Community Planning Partnership (CPP) members and would be reviewed every three years. The Falkirk Plan had a focus on inequalities and aligned closely to the aims of the Falkirk Health and Social Partnership Strategic Plan 2019-2022, particularly Priority 3: Focus on early intervention, prevention and harm reduction.
