A further £1.3m of Community Renewal Funds were awarded for community projects to be delivered by Forth Environment Link and the Green Action Trust on low carbon, food and skills programmes. Arrangements for implementation of these initiatives are now being put underway.
571	24/08/2021	Motions referred to the Executive under Standing Order 31 Communal Areas	The Executive requested that a pilot project be carried out in a block of flats and asked that a paper be brought forward looking at the various options that may be available to enable communal areas to look tidier and improve the tenants' wellbeing. This would include looking at how any solutions would be funded.	Director of Corporate and Housing Services	22 June 2022	In Progress	A pilot would be undertaken over the 3 locality areas (1 block in full council ownership per area) where an enhanced service would be provided to communal areas (closes, bin stores, paths etc.). The Pilot commenced week beginning 3 January 2022 for a period of 6 months with deep cleans being carried out at a number of properties. The regular cleaning schedule in all 3 blocks had commenced with regular checks being carried out. Work instructions were being issued to clean/clear the external areas (bin stores, drying areas etc.) where required.
