#### 1. INTRODUCTION

# 2. EUROPEAN COMMISSION 5<sup>TH</sup> REPORT ON ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND TERRITORIAL COHESION – CONSULTATION ON FUTURE EUROPEAN UNION COHESION POLICY

- 2.1 Committee considered a report by the Director of Corporate and Neighbourhood Services seeking approval to endorse the response submitted to the East of Scotland European Consortium (ESEC) in relation to the European Commission Consultation on the future of EU Cohesion Policy post 2013. The report also considering the Council's future membership of ESEC.
- 2.2 Committee was invited to approve the following recommendations, namely:-
  - (1) to approve the ESEC response to the European Commission consultation on future Cohesion Policy as detailed in the Appendix to the Report;
  - (2) to request that a further report be submitted outlining the wider European Strategy, and
  - (3) to endorse the proposal that the Council renew its membership of ESEC on a 12 month basis and refer this to the Policy and Resources Committee for approval.
- 2.3 Councillor MacDonald, seconded by Councillor Oliver moved the recommendation contained within the Report subject to the deletion of the words "on a 12 month basis" from recommendation (3).
- 2.4 By way of an amendment, Councillor Mahoney, seconded by Councillor Lemetti, moved the recommendations contained within the Report.

- 2.5 On a division, 5 Members voted for the Motion and 7 Members voted for the Amendment.
- 2.6 Accordingly, **AGREED** the recommendations as 2.2 above.
- 2.7. Policy and Resources Committee is therefore invited to endorse the proposal that the Council renew its membership of ESEC on a 12 month basis.
