CL1. MINUTE

There was submitted (circulated) and **APPROVED** Minute of Special Meeting of the Civic Licensing Committee held on 27 March 2007.

CL2. EXCLUSION OF PUBLIC

CL3. APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A NEW TAXI DRIVER LICENCE

The applicant Mr W, Chief Inspector Hutchison and Sergeant McIntyre entered the meeting at this point.

There was submitted Report (circulated) dated 9 August 2007 by the Director of Development Services on an application for a new taxi driver licence advising (a) on the background to the application; (b) that the applicant had previous spent and unspent convictions recorded against him, and (c) on a letter of objection received from Central Scotland Police.

No preliminary matters being raised on the Police letter of objection, copies were tabled.

The Chief Constable's representative was heard in support of the police objection.

Questions were then asked of the Chief Constable's representative by members.

The applicant was heard in support of his application and on the circumstances of the spent and unspent convictions.

Questions were then asked of the applicant by members.

AGREED that a short adjournment take place to enable the Committee to hear advice from the Acting Director of Law and Administration Services.

The applicant and the Chief Constable's representatives left and were then recalled to the meeting.

AGREED that the application for a new taxi driver licence be **REFUSED** on the grounds referred to in Paragraph 5, sub paragraph 3 (a)(ii) of Schedule 1 to the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, namely that the applicant is not a fit and proper person to be the holder of a licence.

The applicant and the Chief Constable's representatives left the meeting at this point.

CL4. APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL OF TAXI OPERATOR LICENCE

There was submitted Report (circulated) dated 9 August 2007 by the Director of Development Services on an application for the renewal of a taxi operator licence advising on the background to the application.
