- (b) Any person interested may inspect the Accounts to be audited and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating thereto and make copies of all or any part of the Accounts and those other documents. Any person wishing to inspect the other documents specified above should make enquiry at Denny Town House.
- (c) Any person interested may object to the annual accounts or to any part of those statements, by:
- (1) sending the objection, in writing, together with a statement of the grounds thereof to Stephen Reid, Ernst & Young LLP, G1 Building, 5 George Square, Glasgow, G2 1DU and to the Controller of Audit, Accounts Commission, 4th Floor, 102 West Port, Edinburgh EH3 9DN not later than Monday 13 July 2020.
 - (2) sending a copy of that objection and statement to the board and to any officer of the board who may be concerned, both at Chief Financial Officer, Denny Town House, Town House Street, Denny, FK6 5DL.
- (d) The auditor shall, if requested by the person objecting, the board, or any officer of the board who may be concerned, afford to that person or board or officer, as the case may be, an opportunity of appearing before and being heard by the auditor with respect to that objection, and any such person or officer may so appear and be heard either personally or by a representative
