

## **Reddingmuirhead and Wallacestone Community Council**

Community Council Meeting Minutes 12/02/2019 @ 7.30pm

Apologies: Iain Shotliff(IS), Douglas Japp(DJ), Kate Connachie(KC), Adana McCue, PC Gary McKay.

12 members of the public were in attendance.

1. The Meeting opened with a Welcome from Chairman who introduced Westquarter and Redding Cricket Club who were invited to give a presentation on their intention to develop a Community Hub at Bailliefields on Standrigg Road, Brightons.

2. Presentation from Westquarter and Redding Cricket Club. Very well received by all. A short video was also shown to give further information on the club's abilities and aims.

3. Minutes of the meeting on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2019 were adopted by JB and PN after an error identified in point 6. This stated an appeal regarding Hillcrest site but no appeal has been made at this stage..

4. Report received from PC Gary McKay. 15 calls in Reddingmuirhead area, nothing serious. 8 calls in Wallacestone area, nothing serious.

5. Safety Report received covering East Grangemouth. 32 issues identified. Mostly dog fouling and litter/fly tipping.

6. Only outstanding matter from previous minutes was the RWCC intention to donate a community award top Braes High School. Ongoing as school have not advised their requirements. **Action - DC to progress**

7. Planning Report. RWCC Comments were submitted to Falkirk Council regarding LDP 2. We expect to hear more about this in May 2019. Discussion on how the views of Falkirk Council and the views of the Scottish Government may differ on the content of the plan.

Only one application in our area which is for a single development at Hillcrest. No objections.

Still awaiting update on Hillcrest site.

Middlerigg Housing application expected end March 2019.

8. Road Lighting continues on Shieldhill Road. No major issues.

9. Convener Report. Nothing to report.

10. Vice Convenor Report. Attended a Haulocaust Event at Braes High School which was very well done.

11. Secretary's Report. Letter received regarding a resident's request to have a Radar Sign placed on Shieldhill Road between Reddingmuirhead and Shieldhill to advise motorists of their speed. **Action – DC to progress.**

Larbert and Stenhousemuir CC have ceased to operate after 4 committee members resigned in December.

A Fireworks Consultation is taking place and groups asked for their input.

12. Treasurer's Report. RWCC continues to be in a healthy financial position with funds of £628.18.

13. Communications Continued concern about Facebook site. To be discussed when KC returns.

14. AOB Intentions to display a sign at the site of the Redding Pit have now been dropped.

Defibrillator leaflets received. While it was not felt appropriate to purchase from the company marketing the product it was felt this would be a good initiative for the community. **Action – To progress further**

Litter Pick discussed as this is being promoted in the national press. Some discussion followed with lots of ideas put forward. To be discussed further at next meeting.

Concern at the number of Traffic Lights throughout the Braes area. It was generally felt that some departments may be catching up on outstanding work.
